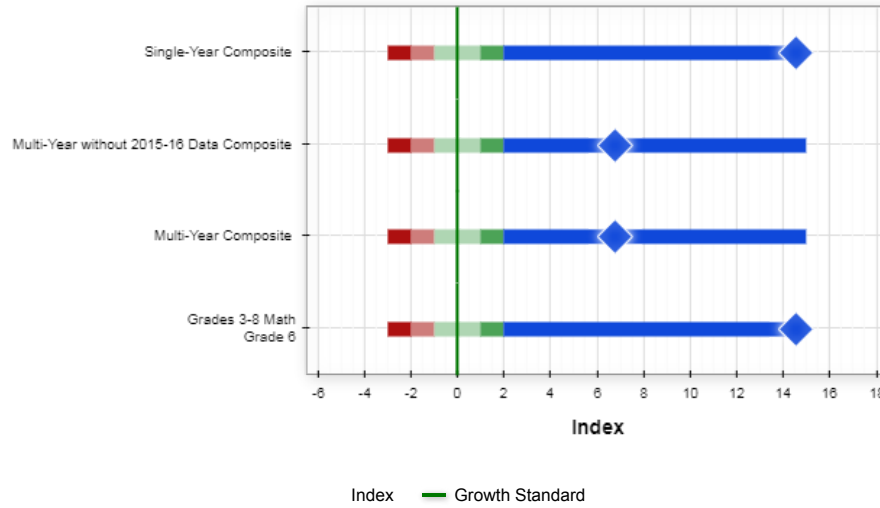

Rules for Effectiveness Level Determination

- Level 5, Most Effective:** Significant evidence that the teacher's students made more progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is 2 or greater)
- Level 4, Above Average Effectiveness:** Moderate evidence that the teacher's students made more progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is between 1 and 2)
- Level 3, Average Effectiveness:** Evidence that the teacher's students made progress similar to the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is between -1 and 1)
- Level 2, Approaching Average Effectiveness:** Moderate evidence that the teacher's students made less progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is between -2 and -1)
- Level 1, Least Effective:** Significant evidence that the teacher's students made less progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is less than -2)

Note: When an index falls exactly on the boundary between two colors, the higher growth color is assigned.
