

Rules for Effectiveness Level Determination

Level 5, Most Effective: Significant evidence that the teacher's students made more progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is 2 or greater)

Level 4, Above Average Effectiveness: Moderate evidence that the teacher's students made more progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is between 1 and 2)

Level 3, Average Effectiveness: Evidence that the teacher's students made progress similar to the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is between -1 and 1)

Level 2, Approaching Average Effectiveness: Moderate evidence that the teacher's students made less progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is between -2 and -1)

Level 1, Least Effective: Significant evidence that the teacher's students made less progress than the Growth Standard (the teacher's index is less than -2)

Note: When an index falls exactly on the boundary between two colors, the higher growth color is assigned.
